**wise men - (Magos) the name given
by the Babylonians to the wise men**

the East - (direction of the sun)

Came - (Erchomai) to go, to follow

His star - Numbers 24:17

**worship Him - homage shown to men
of superior rank.**

**presented - a gift of in expression of
honor.**

“Have come to Worship”

Ps 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before thee.

Re 22:9 - worship God.

Worship = expressing worth

1. They chose to Come (vs. 1,2,11)

**But as for me, I will come into
Your house in the multitude of
Your mercy; In fear of You I will
worship.... Psalm 5:7**

**Draw near to God and He will
draw near to you. James 4:8**

**Seek the Lord while He may be
found, Call upon Him while He
is near. Isaiah 55:6**

2. They were guided by God (vs. 2,5,10)

Stars - Psalm 19:1 Romans 1:20

Scriptures - John 5:39

Saints - Acts 17:2

**And you will seek Me and find
Me, when you search for Me
with all your heart**

3. They submitted to the Savior (v. 11, 12)
