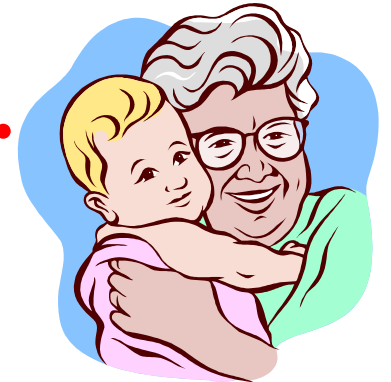


Senior Saints are special!
