Christ's Compassion

1. *Began with His eyes and ears* – 3 days
Matt. 9:36, 14:14, 20:31; Luke 7:13
2. *Stirred His emotions* – “moved with”
“**Splagchnon**” = the seat of the tender affections, esp. kindness, benevolence, compassion; hence our heart (tender mercies, affections, etc.); a heart in which mercy resides.
