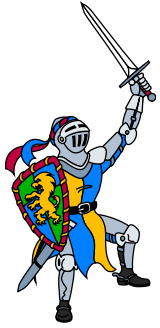

5 Steps to Service

Joshua 1:1-18

- 1. Learn to be a Servant - (v.1)**
- 2. Rely on the Saviour - (vs. 2-5)**
- 3. Admit your Scared - (vs. 6, 7)**
- 4. Learn the Scriptures - (vs. 8,9)**
- 5. Take the Step - (vs. 10-18)**

Sanctification (3:5)

Genesis 2:3 And God blessed the seventh day, and **sanctified** it:

Exodus 19:22 And let the priests also, **sanctify** themselves.

Leviticus 20:7,8 **Sanctify** yourselves therefore, and be ye **holy**: for I am the LORD your God. And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which **sanctify** you.

Sanctification (3:5)

Romans 12:1 ..present your bodies a living sacrifice, **holy**, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service

2Timothy 2:21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, **sanctified**, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

**marvelous, be wonderful, be
surpassing, be extraordinary!**

Exodus 17:14 - Write this for a **memorial**

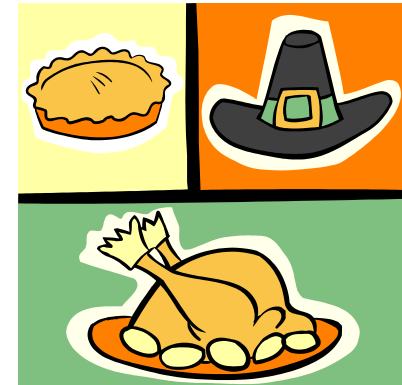
Deuteronomy 6:9,11 - And thou shall write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates... lest thou **forget** the LORD
