## **Let's Read Luke 1:26 – 38**

**In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy God sent the angel Gabriel to a town in Galilee named Nazareth. He had a message for a young woman promised in marriage to a man named Joseph, who was a descendant of King David. Her name was Mary. The angel came to her and said, "Peace be with you! The Lord is with you and has greatly blessed you!" Mary was deeply troubled by the angel's message, and she wondered what his words meant.**

# **Let's Read Luke 1:26 – 38**

**The angel said to her, "Don't be afraid, Mary; God has been gracious to you. You will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High God. The Lord God will make him a king, as his ancestor David was, and he will be the king of the descendants of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end!"**

# **Let's Read Luke 1:26 – 38**

**Mary said to the angel, "I am a virgin. How, then, can this be?" The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and God's power will rest upon you. For this reason the holy child will be called the Son of God. Remember your relative Elizabeth. It is said that she cannot have children, but she herself is now six months pregnant, even though she is very old. For there is nothing that God cannot do."**

# **An Announcement - (v.26)**

# **An Answer – vs. (27-37)**

The Messiah would come and be

1. Born of a virgin and have personhood. (v. 31) Isaiah 7:14 Hebrews 2:14-16
2. Born of David and fulfill promise. (vs. 32-33) Isaiah 9:6 Matthew 2:2
3. Conceived supernaturally and be pure. (34-37) Hebrews 7:26 2 Corinthians 5:21

*It is awesome that Jesus would humble Himself and become a man*



# **An Availability – (v.38)**

*It was the most reasonable service*

- 1. She was in a place where God could speak to her.                      Isaiah 6:8**
- 2. She had was needed by God to do what He planned.                  Romans 6:13**
- 3. She was a servant of the Lord so it wasn't hard to say yes.          Psalm 40:8**
