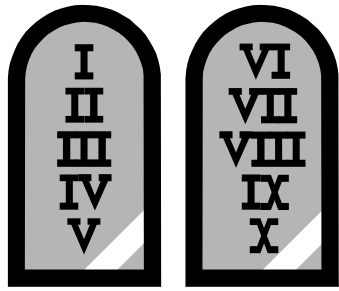

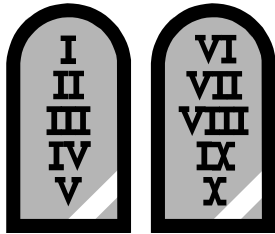

**And yet Jesus said in Matthew 5:17.**

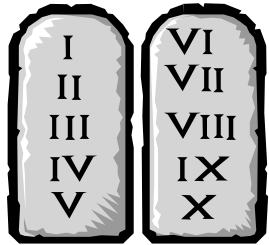
**Jesus and the Sabbath.**

### **3. The Blessing of the Sabbath(v.9)**



- 1. Jesus kept the day and set the pattern that we should too. Luke 4:16**
- 2. It's not a burden but to be a place of rest and relationship. Hebrews 10:25**
- 3. It's blessing should be the person of God reflected in us. Galatians 6:10**

**It's not about us it's about Him!**
