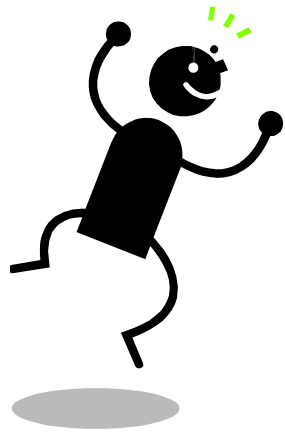

thermostat. It regulates conditions***

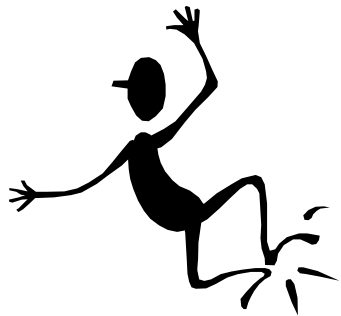
