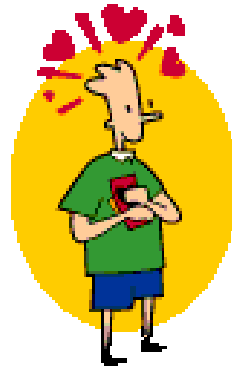

response of a relationship*



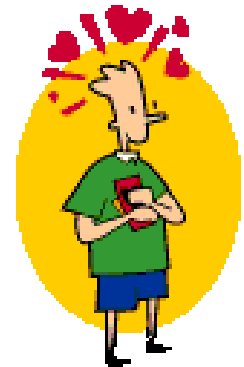
2. Love Compels (v.15)

“feed my lambs”

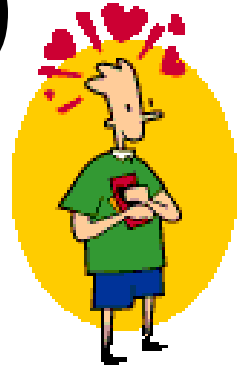
“And He gave some pastor/teachers”

“follow me”

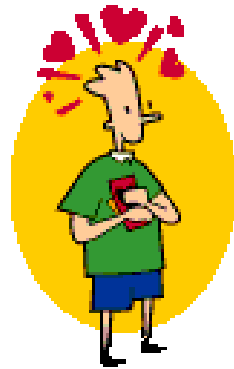
“ slain for the Word of God”
